# PROGRAM LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students must provide qualifying scores in one of the following to be placed at the minimum level (ELS 106) to participate in this program:

- ELS 106 level or above on the Pre-Arrival Test
- iBT TOEFL 55-64
- IELTS 4.5-5.0
- GTEC 946-1075

Santa Rosa Junior College and Foothill and De Anza Colleges require a student to complete ELS level 109 prior to matriculation in college coursework.
